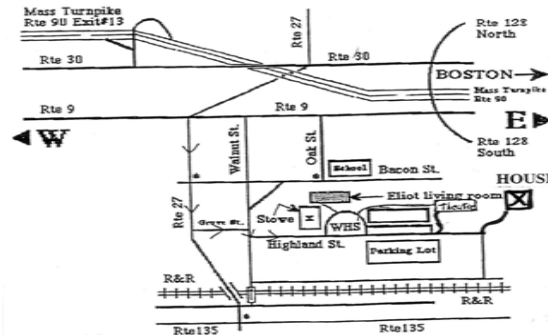

3. At the Mobil Station, take a left onto Grove Street
4. Follow Grove Street to the end.
5. Take a right onto Walnut Street
6. Take a quick left onto Highland Street.
7. The school's address is 12 Highland Street.
8. The parking lot is on the right.

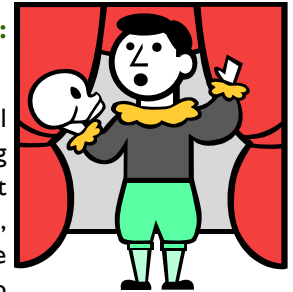
To get to the Theatre Building.

1. Across the street from the parking lot are the school buildings. You will see two driveways leading in. Take the second or upper driveway.
2. Follow the roadway staying to the right as it curves around.
3. The theatre is at the end of the road way and there is a swimming pool beside it.
4. Enter the building by the doorway on the left end (that will be facing you)



Something to Say: Playmaking

Playmaking is a powerful tool for facilitating student's learning, about theatre, themselves, curriculum and the world. This workshop offers an accessible structure for developing original material with students across all grade levels, and identifies strategies for integrating curriculum topics and playmaking, as well as social, personal, and societal exploration.



Bethany Nelson – is a faculty member in Theatre Education at Emerson College, teaching methods classes in theatre, drama, playmaking and multicultural education. An educator and teaching artist for 25 years, Ms. Nelson has worked as a dram specialist in schools consulting in the use of drama as a curriculum tool. She has a M.Ed. from Harvard University Graduate School of Education and is currently pursuing her Ph.D. in Arts & Education at the University of Warwick in Leicester, England. She has published research examining the efficacy of playmaking and process drama in urban classrooms.
